Night & Day (named after the famous Cole Porter standard) is a Melbourne based jazz trio featuring a delightful female vocalist accompanied with Saxophone and Guitar. They are perfect for setting the mood at any occasion whether that is a wedding ceremony or reception, corporate function or playing by the bar in a club.

The groups repertoire features jazz standards from the 1920s through to the 1960s including songs made famous by Ella Fitzgerald, Peggy Lee, Billy Holiday and Ray Charles to name a few. Night & Day perform in a variety of styles, from graceful ballads to up-tempo fun swing tunes, sultry blues, Latin and bossa nova.

For larger events appropriate for dancing it is highly recommended to add a double bass player and drummer.
